Introduction

The Citizens Park Council held its first public meeting on April 29, 1970. The serious deterioration of the New Haven's parks and open spaces was the concern of the organization.

The formal purpose of the organization was: 1. to stimulate public interest in the preservation and maintenance of New Haven parks, 2. to act as a public advocate for and against the City's Park Commission, and 3. to act as a source of volunteer help.
