- VIII. Analysis: The collection consists of loose documents: correspondence, bills, receipts, cancelled checks, promissory notes, case executions, court writs, and miscellaneous. Many of the items placed in the miscellaneous folders are not signed by Dyer White. It is the processor's opinion, based upon the dates of the documents and the handwriting that these items were probably the property of Dyer White.

The notation N.D. signifies that the document is not dated. The notation J.P. signifies Justice of the Peace. For arrangement see the contents sheets.

For Dyer White's scrap paper used by his son, Henry, for school lessons, see MSS 62C, IV:A

It is the processor's opinion that the court cases are, for the most part, related to Dyer White however some of them may be related to Seth P. Staples and/or Samuel J. Hitchcock.

VII. Biographical Note

Dyer White, the son of the Reverend Stephen White, was born on May 20, 1762, in Windham, Conn. He studied law and in 1785 was admitted to the bar in New Haven. He resided in New Haven until his death on Nov. 2, 1841. He married three times. By his third wife, Mrs. Eunice Basset, he had a son, Henry, who also became a lawyer.

In addition to his law practice he held a number of positions and appointments: clerk of the Superior Court, 1801-1806, and 1807-1821; clerk of the New Haven City Court, 1794-1815; judge of the New Haven County Court, 1806, 1807, 1808, 1809, 1810, 1814 and 1816; deputy inspector of Beef and Pork in New Haven (dates unknown); Collector of the Revenue, 1791-1801; Justice of the peace, 1794-1811.

White also held several positions to which no reference is made in his papers. They are as follows: Director of the New Haven Bank, 1818, 1820; Director of the Derby Bank, 1816; New Haven City Councilman, 1794-95; and New Haven City Alderman, 1798-1800.

White was associated with the Wharf Company and the Union Wharf Company. The position he held with respect to these companies could not be determined by the processor.

Legal documents and papers of court cases--some of which are signed by Dyer White, attorney, and others, because of their dates are presumed to relate to him--appear with all legal documents of the White Collection. A folder of undated and unsigned notes pertaining to cases which the processor assumes to have been written by Dyer White were also placed with the legal documents of the White Collection.

Stephen White, son of Captain John White, was born in Upper Middletown, June 8, 1718 and died January 9, 1794 in Windham, Conn. He graduated from Yale College in 1736 and was the Pastor of the Congregational Church in Windham for 53 years. On Sept. 2, 1741, he married Mary Dyer of Windham (Jan. 31, 1719 - May 27, 1802) and had 13 children, one of these was Dyer White.
