- VII. Biographical note: Robert J. Gregson grew up in Chatham, N.J. He attended the Hartford Art School, graduated from the University of Hartford, and attended the Art Institute of Chicago. Bob did teaching, exhibiting, planning events at the Art Institute of Chicago, the Capital Childrens Museum in Washington, D.C., the Wadsworth Atheneum (Hartford). He co-directed the Sidewalk Inc. projects in Hartford and has written and designed several books and catalogues. He is currently cultural planner for the City of New Haven, Office of Cultural Affairs. He designated the Whitney Library of the NHCHS as repository for his papers in 1984.
