## Introduction to the New Haven Architects Collection

This collection consists of two boxes of documents, photographs, negatives, and newspaper articles on architects of the New Haven area. Box one contains fairly modern material on architects and buildings from the 1960's and 1970's. The eleven folders are divided to contain the work of one particular architect or the work of partners. (See Roy and Millard) The folders that contain newspapers or miscellaneous photos are organized according to year or the common topic they refer to.

The second <sup>box</sup> folder contains the work of architects who designed buildings during the middle and late 1800's and early 1900's. Again the folders are divided by architect, the exceptions being letters and the plans for the Children's Community Center of the New Haven Orphan Asylum founded in 1833.
