#### Introduction

Thomas Munson was born September 12, 1612 in Rattlesden, Suffolk, England. He arrived in Connecticut in 1637 and came to New Haven in 1640. He died in 1685 in New Haven.

The Thomas Munson Foundation, an association of descendents, was founded on August 8, 1982 in Groton, New York.

The collection includes general information about the Munson family and the Foundation. It publishes a newsletter, maintains a Scholarship Committee and has made a significant contribution to genealogical research through the publication of <u>The Munson</u> <u>Record</u>.

In addition to this manuscript collection, material about Thomas Munson, the Munson family, and the Thomas Munson Foundation has been cataloged and can be found in the library collections.

This material was given to the Whitney Library in 2006 by the Foundation. There are no restrictions on access to the collection.
